**FEES**

<b>Application Fee (non-refundable)</b>	\$50 for each <i>new</i> student
<b>Registration Fee: (non-refundable)</b>	\$400 per family, payable upon acceptance. \$200 per family for re-enrolling students who complete the enrollment agreement and pay by the first business day in March. Re-enrollment completed and paid after the first business day in March will be \$400.
<b>Books, Tests, Supplies:</b>	\$200 per year per student. Book fees are due with tuition payment when paid in full. Families that opt for the monthly tuition payment schedule will have book fees included in the monthly payments. <b>(All book and tech fees paid are non-refundable.)</b>
<b>Tech Fee:</b>	\$50.00 per student due when tuition is paid in full or will be included in monthly payment schedule <b>(non-refundable).</b>
<b>ACT Fee (11<sup>th</sup>/12<sup>th</sup>):</b>	Current ACT rate (approximately \$50)
<b>NSF Fees:</b>	Charged according to bank charge.
<b>Late Payment Fee:</b>	\$20 per student per month when not paid by the 5 <sup>th</sup> of each month. (All payments are due on the 1 <sup>st</sup> of each month.)
<b>Late Pickup Fee:</b>	Students left at school after 4:10 p.m. will be charged \$25.00 for the first 15 minutes and \$15.00 for each additional 15-minute increment.

**TUITION AND FEES**

Tuition, book and tech fees will be combined into 12 equal payments which begin in May. Students enrolling after May, must become current with pay schedule. Attendance during any part of a school month will require full payment for that month. All prior monthly payments made before withdrawal are **non-refundable**.

Transportation, food, uniforms, and certain student supplies are not included in the tuition and fees. No student with an outstanding balance from the prior school year will be permitted to begin classes in the fall. All accounts must be paid in full before credits or transcripts can be transferred to other schools and colleges. GCA has the right to terminate

the enrollment of any student for failure of parents to pay part or all of their financial obligations. If an account becomes more than 30 days delinquent, the student(s) may be suspended. If the account is not paid within an additional 15 days, the student(s) may be dismissed from the school. For your protection and to assist in bookkeeping, all payments need to be made by check or online. ***Please do not pay in cash. Tuition is due the first business day of the month.***
